I can follow the arrows that lead me around the library and around all book shelves.
















About the library


There are people who work at the library who I can talk to.

Most of the library staff wear a library uniform and have a name badge.




The library is usually a quiet place where people talk quietly, relax and read books.

I can talk to someone who works there if I would like to become a member of the library.




I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number and email address and the library staff will enter my details on their computer.

I am now a member of the library and I will be given a library card














When I visit the library

In the library there will be lots of shelves of books that I can choose from.



I can borrow a book and take it home with me.

The staff can show me how to borrow the book and tell me when I need to bring the book back to the library.











There is a shelf that I can use to return my books. I can ask staff if I need help to bring a book back



The library will also have some computers. The library staff can help me to get on a computer.

If I use the computers I will wipe the computer before and after I use them. There is a special bin that I can put my used wipes or gloves in.



To use the computers I may need to wait if it is busy.












The library has toilets I can use, they are at the front part of our library.
