If I am nervous about going I can talk to someone and ask questions first, I can call **0151 511 7744**.



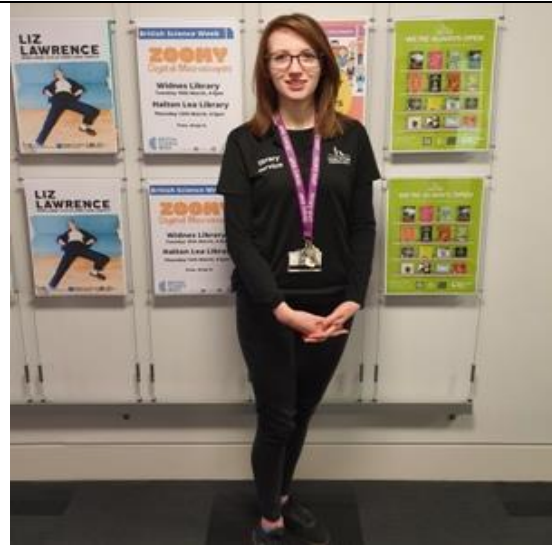
I can ask the person for a tour of the library

When I visit the library

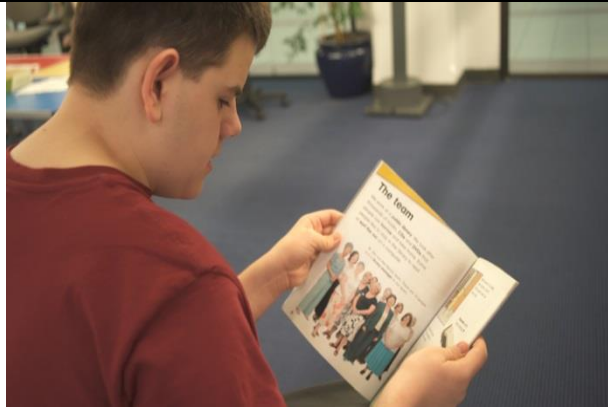
In the library there will be lots of shelves of books

The library has areas for children and young people, where I can relax.

I can play fun board games in this area.

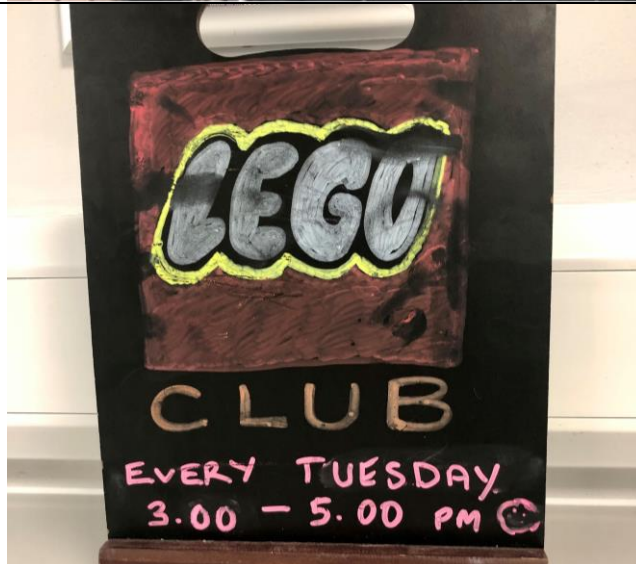


This library sometimes runs fun events for kids, young people and also adults.
